TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Singapore's tropical climate is hot and humid all year round and is affected by two different monsoon periods. The Northeast Monsoon season takes place from December to March with frequent rain. The Southwest Monsoon season falls between May and September and is marginally dryer. Soak up the lively atmosphere during the months of July to September when many festivals such as the Singapore Food Festival and the Great Singapore Sale are in full swing.

Malaysia has a tropical climate with high temperatures and high humidity throughout the year. Monsoon season for the south-west is from May to September and the north-east from November to March. On the west coast, the green months are May to October, while on the east coast, the green months are September to December. Enjoy the lush countryside and bountiful waterfalls when visiting after the green season.

ETIQUETTE

In respect for local traditions and religious beliefs, arms and legs should be covered and shoes removed when visiting places of worship. Food should be handled with the right hand. Topless sunbathing (by women) is not permitted. Pointing with the foot is not considered polite.

VISAS & PASSPORTS

All travellers to Singapore and Malaysia must carry a passport valid for at least six months beyond the date of departure from Australia. As visa information can change at any time, we recommend you seek advice regarding passports, visas and other travel requirements for the countries you intend visiting from the Australian Government at smartraveller.gov.au.

RAMADAN

Singapore, Bintan Island and Malaysia include a large Muslim population. Ramadan is observed by many throughout these countries and we recommend you make yourself aware of how that may affect your travel. Daytime is often quieter, business hours are generally shorter with restaurants and cafés screened off or closed out of respect for those who are fasting. In the evening, cities come to life, public places will be busy well into the early hours of the morning. Ramadan is from 9 March to 8 April 2024 and from 28 February to 29 March 2025.

LANGUAGES

Malay, English, Mandarin and Tamil are the official languages of Singapore. Bahasa Malaysia (Malay) is the official language of Malaysia, however English is widely spoken. Bahasa Indonesia is the official language of Bintan Island. English is widely spoken particularly in major towns and resort areas.

TIME

Singapore and Malaysia are both two hours behind Australia Eastern Standard Time (AEST).

Singapore: Singapore Dollar (SGD)
 Bintan Island: Indonesian Rupiah (IDR)
 Malaysia: Malaysian Ringgit (MYR)

HISTORY & HERITAGE

Delve into Singapore and Malaysia's interesting past. In Singapore, explore wartime history at Changi Museum, learn about the history of the iconic Merlion and visit the nation's oldest museum, the National Museum of Singapore. In Malaysia, George Town and Malacca serve as living museums with well-preserved heritage buildings and historical sites. Visit the blue Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion and the Khoo Kongsi clan house. Learn of Malaysia's wartime history at Fort Cornwallis in Penang and the National Monument in Kuala Lumpur.

ARCHITECTURAL MARVELS

Be impressed by architectural wonders, from soaring skyscrapers to remarkable bridges. In Singapore, you can't miss the engineering feat of Marina Bay Sands® and the giant Supertrees of Gardens by the Bay. See the lotus bloom shaped ArtScience Museum, The Helix bridge, and colonial Raffles Singapore. In Malaysia, see the tallest twin towers in the world, the Petronas Twin Towers, and in complete contrast, the beautiful Sultan Abdul Samad Building in Kuala Lumpur. Walk along Langkawi's SkyBridge, the world's longest curved suspension bridge.

LIVELY NEIGHBOURHOODS

Explore Singapore's neighbourhoods and gain a great insight into the city's diversity. Chinatown is a bustling mix of old and new while Little India buzzes with a vibrant Indian community. AUTHENTIC CUISINE

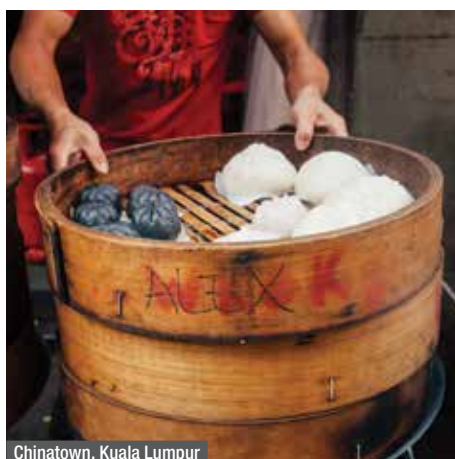

SACRED TEMPLES

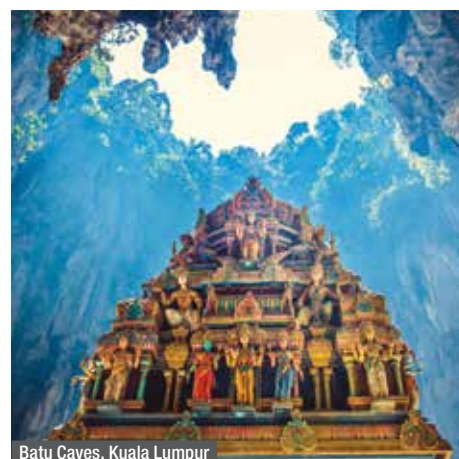

Visit the Buddha Tooth Relic Temple & Museum in Singapore, which houses an impressive collection of religious artefacts, and view the 'Floating Mosque' in Kota Kinabalu in Borneo which is great to photograph as it appears to float on water. In Kuala Lumpur see vividly decorated Thean Hou Temple and don't miss visiting the popular Batu Caves which are guarded by a large statue of a Hindu deity. Kek Lok Si Temple is a highlight when in Penang.
